Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am delighted that your girl will be joining Ophelia's Place as a participant in our special 4-day camps! We have a variety of different camps this year, appealing to diverse interests, so be sure to check out all our offerings on our website, www.opheliasplace.net. This letter provides some information to make sure that your girl will have the best experience she can during her time with us.

- ❖ All camps but one are from 10am-3pm (*Women Who Rock* is 12-4pm).
- ❖ A snack will be provided but **please send your girl with a sack lunch each day**. This ensures she will have the foods she likes and will accommodate individual dietary needs. A snack will also be provided during drop-in hours (3-6pm all summer) if she chooses to stay at OP after camp ends.
- ❖ Equine events are held off-site and transportation is provided from OP **only** for the *Blue Moon Bonfire* event. You will need to provide transportation to and from all other equine events.
- ❖ Please note that our *Animation & Game Design* camp will be held at the **downtown campus** of LCC, in room 104 (101 W 10th Ave, Eugene, OR 97401). This location is across from the Public Library and near the downtown LTD bus station. You will need to provide transportation to and from this camp.
- ❖ Participants are encouraged to bring water bottles to stay hydrated, and sunblock if they are attending equine events. Layered clothing is also recommended.
- ❖ If your girl has a bee allergy, please make sure she has the appropriate emergency kit with her at all times.
- ❖ We appreciate being able to take pictures of participants for our website and other OP promotional purposes. Attached is a photo release form. If you do not return it to us, we will assume you do NOT wish your girl's image to be used in any materials or media.
- ❖ **All** OP events are sliding scale and have scholarships; please don't hesitate to ask questions about payment options and scholarships.
